What is the process of election/selection of Fellows and Members?	The nominees for Fellowship are elected through a stringent three- tier process involving peer review by eminent experts in relevant fields and shortlisting in two stages by INAE Committees. The final selection is done by the INAE Governing Council headed by President, INAE and comprising of the INAE leadership and eminent Fellows from Academia, R&D and Industry from across the country, representing all 10 Engineering Sections of INAE, based on the entire gamut of engineering disciplines and allied areas.	Membership Committee headed by a Vice-President, of INAE and comprising of senior INAE Fellows from Academia, industry and R&D from across the country, which are ratified by the INAE Governing Council.
What are the Benefits?	INAE Fellows may nominate potential candidates for Fellowship, Foreign Fellowship and INAE Young Associates, participate in INAE events, workshops, meetings and schemes and can use the suffix 'FNAE' to their names for life.
